Scope & Content

The history of James Crawford's family is presented including their settlement in Augusta County, Virginia in the 1730s. James was the 5th of 10 children born to Alexander and Mary Lessley Hottel Crawford. He studied law and graduated at the head of his class in Fulton, Missouri. He married Jemima Frances Hurt on February 14, 1865. After the war, he went to Baltimore, Maryland for an unknown period of time. He moved to Chattanooga, Tennessee where he died June 9, 1887. Information is provided regarding his descendants to 1974.

Historical/Biographical Note

This biography is dedicated to the "fine and loyal members of the James S.A. Crawford Chapter of the United Daughters of the Confederacy". Caroline Condon Leech founded the Chapter and named it for her favorite uncle, James S.A. Crawford who served with distinction as Captain of the Night Hawk Rangers, 14th VA Calvary.
