Scope & Content: This one page letter to a daughter from her father describes a fire in Waynesboro, Virginia that took place in May 1861. The author also refers to battles at Harpers Ferry and Norfolk. This letter may have been addressed to Mrs. H.M. Irvine, as her name appears on one of the folds, as if an address. On the back of this letter, someone (illegible signature) wrote a prayer. This is in a different handwriting than the letter about the fire.
