Historical/Biographical Note

Fitzhugh Elder was a Staunton lawyer and early member of the Augusta County Historical Society. William P. Tams, Jr. (1883-1997) was a founding member of ACHS. He graduated from VPI in 1902 with a degree in engineering. He founded Gulf Smokeless Coal Company at Tams, WVA in 1907. He served as a major in WWI. Richard Phillips Bell III, M.D. was the first president of ACHS. He served with the 8th Army Medical Corps, European Theater, during WWII.
