Scope & Content

The Pioneer was published by the high school students of the Beverley Manor Academy. It lists the names and photographs for the graduates and staff. It also contains a photograph of the school as it appeared in 1916. Several pages are devoted to essays written by students. The final pages are advertisements for local businesses and patrons.

Historical/Biographical Note

Beverley Manor Academy High School opened in the historic Staunton Academy building on September 25, 1905. It was considered first of the new type in Augusta County which meant it had to meet requirements set by the State Board of Education for high schools. It had an enrollment of 37 students the first year. In 1912 the Beverley Manor Academy moved to Thornrose Avenue.
