Scope & Content

The November 22, 1963 issue of the Staunton Leader covered the assassination of President John F. Kennedy. The other newspapers and The Mary Baldwin Bulletin provided an in-depth coverage of the visit of President Dwight D. Eisenhower on October 27, 1960.

Historical/Biographical Note

On October 27, 1960, President Eisenhower arrived in the Valley of Virginia to visit his mother's birthplace near Mount Sidney and the Manse in Staunton in which President Woodrow Wilson was born. He spoke from the porch of Mary Baldwin College, as did President Wilson in 1912. A crowd of over 10,000 Stauntonians jammed the front lawn of the college and the surrounding area to see and hear President Eisenhower.
