Scope & Content

Original and copy of a portion of instructions to overseers of roads dated September 30, 1871; twenty road tax receipts from 1871-1876; one bill and 3 receipts for Sunnyside School. 1873; appointment of surveyor of public roads as well as a listing of those people assigned to keep the roads in lawful repair; an 1872 bill for work done for the county and a nine page ledger (not dated); also a copy of a supplement to The Staunton Leader related to the United Fund dated October 2, 1961.

Historical/Biographical Note

Most of the road orders pertain to the Riverheads District in Augusta County during the 1870's. Nimrod M. Green was appointed surveyor of public roads on May 10, 1879. .
