Scope & Content

The collection contains postcards written to John W. Todd, a Staunton, VA merchant concerning his business as a supplier of hay and oat, corn, and wheat seed that he shipped by rail to North Carolina and points in VA. Ten empty envelopes are included in the collection, most addressed to Mrs. L. A. Grady at Sulphur Mine in Louisa County, VA. Others are to Geo. Ware, R. L. Swann, Thos. Saunders, and Caroline Sanders. A newspaper obituary for Charles L. Todd, son of John Todd, is also included. He died 2/1/1929.
