Scope & Content

Fitting, M. A., The Radford Letters, History of a Virginia Family. Blacksburg, VA: Pocahontas Press, Inc., 2002. This book is a biography of Dr. John Blair Radford, b. 1813, a medical doctor who lived at Arnheim in Montgomery County, VA. His story is told mainly through a large number of family letters giving a window on life in the mid-19th century and the relationships among family members. Much of the book takes place during the Civil War.
