Scope & Content

This is a comprehensive genealogy of one of the early Glick families in the Shenandoah Valley of Virginia. Most of the information found in this undertaking can be documented by deeds, wills, marriage records, tax records, settlement lists, family bibles, gravestones and other records. Also interjected are family tradition and hypothetical opinion. This book covers the descendants of John Glick Jr. who was most likely born in Germany in 1754. He married Elizabeth Bauserman. Many photographs of people as well as family homes are included. An addendum of 10 pages is included with new information, which substantiates certain assumptions and refutes others.

Historical/Biographical Note

The original patriarch of the Shenandoah Valley family, recorded in this book, was John Glick, Sr. (Johannes Glick, Sr.). His name appears in the civil records as Shenandoah County, Virginia, as John Click, Sr. while his son John appears as John Click, Jr. Tradition in the writer's branch of the family says he came from Hanau, Hesse (Hessen), Germany and ever settled originally in Pennsylvania but came directly to the Shenandoah Valley to establish his home.
