From the 1901 Constitutional Directory: "Braxton, Allen Caperton. Staunton. Democrat. Represents Augusta County and city of Staunton. Born at Union, Monroe County, W.Va., Feburary 6, 1862. Educated at Pampatike Academy, King William County, Va. Lawyer. City attorney and Commonwealth's attorney for city of Staunton 1886 to 1890. Member of Independent Order of Odd Fellows and Knights of Pythias."
