Mr. E. Walton Opie observed in his editorial notes that the club's 59th anniversary was a modest one as it included no review of the major contributions to the community's life. He highlighted over a dozen that the Club had made over the years. Of major importance was the organization and financing of a school for adults as a move to reduce illiteracy in the 1930's. It was continued for several years until adult education was introduced in the public school system.

Historical/Biographical Note

The Staunton Rotary Club was organized in February 1920 by a group of local businessmen. The first officers were President- M.J. Payne, Vice President-Gilpin Wilson, Secretary-F.N. Moran, Treasurer-Albert Shultz, and Sergeant at Arms-K.H. Knorr.
