Scope & Content

The communication in this collection pertains to the purchase of machinery by bids. The Staunton purchasing committee consisted of George M. Smiley, W.A. McComb and Bruce Whitmore. Mr. Craven in Greensboro NC was bidding on a contract to sell “dump beds” and “crushers”. He was awarded a contract for two “quick dump beds” but was not successful in his bid for “crushers

Historical/Biographical Note

The letter written by Mr. McComb was on letterhead of Augusta Fruit Growers Association, dated February 18, 1909. The note informing Mr. Craven that he had been awarded the contract for the “quick dump beds” was written on letterhead of Hotel Augusta, Proprietor J.E. Porter
