Scope & Content

The book seems to be an all-purpose notebook for listing general financial records. It includes payments for pole taxes as well as sales for a grocery store. Both Sam Bell and Rebeckah Bell have signed the book to authenticate the entries. Possibly one was a government official, who used to book to record tax payments and the other used it for recording accounts at a grocery. The dates of the entries are scattered rather than sequential as if one person used the book, but did not fill up all the pages and then a second person used the remaining pages.
