Hold onto your hats! The speaker for the 20th Annual Augusta County Historical Society banquet on Saturday, March 19, 2016, could very well be the best ever! Jon Jarvis, THE Director of the National Park Service, will regale us with the story of "America's Best Idea: The National Park Service." The agency turns 100 this year and Jarvis, a Rockbridge County native who has spent 40 years wearing the NPS green uniform, revels in being able to spin stories about the only federal agency with "a constitutional mandate to have fun (the Pursuit of Happiness)!"

And what place is more appropriate as a venue for Jarvis to talk about the nation's more than 400 historic sites, beautiful landscapes, and amazing places than right here? Not only are we the home to Shenandoah National Park, the Shenandoah Valley Battlefields National Historic District, the Blue Ridge Parkway, and the Appalachian Trail, but Stuarts Draft is the birthplace of John Colter. You might remember that this Lewis & Clark Expedition scout went on to became a famous mountain man and the first white man to explore Yellowstone, which is the FIRST National Park! And, guess which U.S. President signed the National Park Service into existence a century ago? If you said Woodrow Wilson you are absolutely right!

As always the evening at the Stonewall Jackson Hotel & Conference Center is designed to provide a special historical journey into the past as well as a gathering of those who want to support the historical society's mission of "Preserving the Past for the Future." The festivities begin at 6 p.m. with social time. Dinner follows at 6:45 with awards and the keynote speaker immediately after that. The night will also feature a fundraiser drawing for trips, pieces of art, and other prizes.

The opportunity to have Director Jon Jarvis come home to the Valley and speak about our special places as well as those across our great nation is a once-in-a-lifetime event.
